Next, each hospital profile provides data on how the hospital’s performance rates against other hospitals in the state, against the national average and against the nation’s “best practices.” Hospital profiles are arranged by these Critical Conditions; Heart Attack Care, Heart Failure Care, Pneumonia Care, Surgical Care, plus 4 new categories:

- ❑ **(NEW) Chest Pain/ Possible Heart Attack Care**
- ❑ **(NEW) Examines the Use of Medical Imaging**
- ❑ **(NEW) Summaries of the Survey of Patients’ Hospital Experiences**
 - ◆ Summaries are based upon answers to questions like: overall rating of the hospital, communication between staff and patients, cleanliness, and any follow-up information or treatments given and explained.

Each regional volume of *The Comparative Guide to American Hospitals* also includes:

- ❑ **Regional State-by-State Statistical Summary Tables:** Shows at a glance how hospitals in the same state score and compare with each other. They are arranged alphabetically by state in easy-to-read landscape format.
- ❑ **Appendix A: 30-Day Mortality Chart:** Lists hospitals nationwide that are “better” and “worse” than national averages, plus a State Summary of Hospital Mortality.
- ❑ **Appendix B: 30-Day Readmission Charts (NEW):** lists hospitals nationwide that are “better” and “worse” than national averages, plus a State Summary of Hospital Readmission Rates.
- ❑ **Appendix C: Glossary of Terms:** Lists 50 medical terms to make the best use possible of the data in this edition.
- ❑ **Regional Hospital Profile Index:** Lists hospitals alphabetically, including city and state.
