## *The Grey House Safety & Security Directory*

“Since 1943, A.M. Best has published A.M. Best’s Safety & Security Directory. Grey House Publishing purchased this publication and has published it since 2002. The material included in this work is extremely useful. Chapters include Safety Management, Consulting, Insurance and Loss Control, Electrical and Lighting Safety, Employee Health Maintenance and Ergonomics, Facilities Monitoring, and Fall Protection. A typical chapter covers a given topic and includes sections on OSHA requirements, articles on selected aspects of the topic (denoted as “Training Articles”), self-inspection checklists, and a directory of vendors appropriate to each chapter’s topic. Advertisements are placed within their corresponding sections. Articles introduce major points of safety, followed by a brief statement about the author. Many authors are either manufacturers or consultants. This resource serves as an excellent desktop resource for the safety officer of an organization and others interested in safety and security.”
