Brief descriptions and other details are included depending on the type of listing. *The Complete Directory for People with Chronic Illness* begins with the article “Next Steps After Your Diagnosis”. A cross-reference chart of Chronic Illness to Body System is also included at the front of the volume.

Following the introductory material, the 89 specific chronic illness chapters are arranged alphabetically by the name of the illness. Chapters begin with an easy-to-understand description of the condition, including cause, symptoms and common treatment options.

After each illness description there is a wide range of condition-specific associations, state agencies, resource centers, support groups and print and electronic resources. These listings include complete contact information with website and email addresses, where available.

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Most listings also feature key personnel and a brief description of the organization. Other information is offered based on the type of listing, for example magazine entries will often include frequency of publication, number of pages, and subscription cost, while association entries may include year founded, number of members, and annual dues.

Several supplemental chapters offer more resources for those in the chronic illness community. The General Resources chapter lists associations, state agencies, resource centers, support groups and print and electronic resources that are non-specific to any condition. The Wish Foundations chapter contains listings for organizations who work to fulfill the wishes of children with chronic or terminal illness. Finally, a Death & Bereavement chapter offers support services for those who find themselves or a loved one close to death or in the grieving process.

The last portion of *The Complete Directory for People with Chronic Illness* is made up of two indexes. The first is an Entry Name Index, which is an alphabetical listing of all entries in the book. The second is a Geographic Index, which organizes all listings according to their geographic location.
