## *Encyclopedia of Invasions & Conquests, From the Ancient Times to the Present*

“The third edition of this major work has been updated with new articles, the Russian incursion into Ukraine, and seven section introductions. The book is divided into four major sections: section one is the largest, comprising seven parts divided into the following time periods: the Ancient World, the Classical World, the Dark and Middle Ages, the Renaissance and the Age of Exploration, the Age of Revolutions and Napoleon, the Age of Empires, and the 20th-21st Centuries. Each of these seven parts have numerous entries that describe the event, followed by *see also* references and a short bibliography. Section two provides a number of primary source materials for reading and additional background to the entries in section one. Section three is a chronological timeline of all of the entries contained in the book, and section four is the bibliography. There are a large number of maps (over 100), which provide excellent visual references to all of the content. This volume is a necessary reference work for any high school or academic library.”
