The 1,300 listings are arranged by state, with individual facilities listed alphabetically by name. Each profile includes a wealth of valuable information that goes far beyond address, phone, fax, and web site. You will find a description of the facility, which frequently includes the types of programs offered, such as faith-based or harm reduction, the physical setting of the facility, educational components, and the demographics of its residents. To further complete the profile of each residential facility, you'll find costs, average stay, number of counselors and residents, insurance accepted, and accreditation. Rounding off the data in the *Directory of Drug & Alcohol Residential Rehabilitation Facilities* is a valuable list of key personnel, including executive, administrative, and clinical titles.

Three indexes help narrow the search for the right facility—by age, by treatment program, and by name. The Age Index orders all the facilities by six age ranges: All Ages; Under 13; 13-17; 18-25; Over 18; Over 30. The Entry Name index lists alphabetically all the residential rehabilitation facilities and resources that appear in the directory. The Type of Treatment Index is a listing of all facilities by type of program offered, including not only the more obvious categories such as *Drug and Alcohol* and *Long-Term Residential*, but some other, more specialized categories, such as *Women and Children*, *Programs in Spanish*, and *Gambling Addiction Programs*.

The last section in the directory profiles hundreds of drug & alcohol rehabilitation information resources. Here you will find contact information for the Associations, Periodicals, Research and Resource Centers, Support Groups, Trade Shows and Conferences, Videos, and Web Sites in the field, enabling users to form their own valuable network of resources for information and changes in the drug & alcohol rehabilitation field.

As with many of our directories, the *Directory of Drug & Alcohol Residential Rehabilitation Facilities* is also available for subscription online, or as a customized database.
