Encyclopedia of Warrior Peoples & Fighting Groups

“Readers will find useful information here concerning war and insurrection covering 4,000 years, from the “first warrior people,” the Akkadians (2300 B.C.) to the Green Berets and ISIS. The 144 entries from 21 contributors range from a page to four pages, with references provided, although some seem to date from earlier editions of this work. There are also 250 pages of “Readings,” including 126 pages from a famous 1851 volume called *Marathon to Waterloo*, by Edward Creasy, outlining the 15 most important battles of the previous 2,200 years. Other texts include items from the first century to the twenty-first century.

This volume provides wide-ranging information on the conflicts and confrontations in our history and the people who fought in them. The text reads easily and is accessible to interested teens and adults. Libraries that serve these populations should consider this book. “
