

HOW TO USE BOOKS IN PRINT®

Books In Print® is designed to be easily searchable by both author and title. The set consists of seven volumes:

Volumes I through 4 arranged alphabetically by Title, Volume 5 with the conclusion of Titles and beginning of Authors, Volume 6 exclusively dedicated to Authors, and Volume 7 containing the conclusion of Authors and the Publisher Name, and Wholesaler & Distributor indexes.

Entries in the Title Index includes the following bibliographic information, when available: author, co-author, editor, co-editor, translator, co-translator, title, number of volumes, edition, series information, number of pages, language if other than English, whether or not illustrated, grade range, year of publication, type of binding if other than cloth over boards, price, International Standard Book Number, publisher's order number, imprint, and publisher's name.

ISBNs marked with an asterisk and in bold type are new to this edition of **Books In Print®**.

HOW TO FIND A TITLE ENTRY

Titles in **Books In Print®** have been alphabetized using the following rules:

- ❖ Initial articles of titles in English, French, German, Italian, and Spanish are not included for sorting purposes.
- ❖ Titles beginning with acronyms appear before those beginning with words. For example, B E A M A Directory precedes Baal, Babylon.
- ❖ As a general rule U.S. and UN are filed in strict alphabetical order unless the author/publisher requests that the title be filed as if it were spelled out.
- ❖ Titles beginning with numeric's may be found near the end of the Title Index, after the "Z" entries. See the "Numeric Titles" section in Volume 5.
- ❖ As a general rule, Dr., Mr., Mrs., and St., are filed in strict alphabetical order unless the author/publisher requests that the title be filed as if it were spelled out.

PRICES LISTED IN BOOKS IN PRINT

The prices listed in **Books In Print®** represent an effort on the part of publishers to be as accurate as possible. However, some price changes will occur before the next edition of the book is published. Users of this volume are encouraged to consult the **Books In Print Supplement®**, published in March 2023, to access those changes. Prices printed are generally list prices, and trade discounts have not been indicated.

HOW TO FIND AN AUTHOR ENTRY

Entries in the Author Index have been revised to provide the contributor(s) name(s), title, subtitle, and title supplement. The last piece of information is a cross-reference page number that directs the user to the book's full entry in the main Title Index. Contributor cross references for joint authors are also included in this index.

If a book has two authors or editors, a listing is included under the author or editor named first and the other is cross-referenced. Books with more than two authors or editors list only the name of the first followed by et al. Author names in **Books In Print®** have been alphabetized using the following rules:

- ❖ Proper names beginning with "Mc" and "Mac" are filed in strict alphabetical order. For example, entries for contributors' names such as MacAdam, MacAvory, and MacCarthy are located prior to the pages with entries for names such as McAdam, McCoy, and McDermott.
- ❖ Compound names are listed under their first component and cross-referenced under their last. For example, Van Holland is listed under Van and cross-referenced under Holland.

- ❖ When names are represented with initials, they are alphabetized before author first names. For example, Smith, H. C. appears before Smith, Harold A.

The editors of **Books In Print®** rely on publishers to provide standard spelling and format for each author. However, if a publisher is inconsistent in use of an author's name, there may be duplicate listings for that author in this volume. While most of these duplicate listings will appear in close proximity to each other, some may be quite far removed. An example of this is the use of Goethe for some titles and von Goethe for others. The editors have made every attempt to reduce variant forms of authors' names in **Books In Print®** and have cross-referenced many entries subject to this situation. It is still suggested that searches include all possible variant forms of author names.

THE BOOKS IN PRINT FAMILY

In order to search books by subject, it is necessary to use the companion publication **Subject Guide to Books In Print®**. Likewise, information on recently published works may not have been received in time for inclusion in **Books In Print®** and should be searched in **Books In Print Supplement®**. Books yet to be published will be found in **Forthcoming Books™**.

Some books are better searched in other R.R. Bowker titles. For example, a more comprehensive listing of elementary and secondary school textbooks can be found in **EL-Hi Textbooks & Serials In Print®**, while **Law Books and Serials In Print™**, **A Multimedia Sourcebook** contains several non-print media and serials indexes in addition to the law titles found in **Books In Print®**.

PUBLISHER INDEXES

The publisher's indexes have been compiled from R. R. Bowker's Publisher Authority Database, which is regularly updated with information received directly from publishers. In addition to corrections to editorial and ordering addresses, telephone numbers, email and Web site addresses, name changes, new imprints, and so on, new publishers, distributors, and wholesalers have been added since the 2022-2023 edition of **Books In Print** and **Subject Guide to Books In Print** as well.

There are two indexes provided in this section:

- *Publisher Name Index listing more than 112,000 publishers*
- *Wholesaler & Distributor Name Index listing more than 2,200 distributors and 1,000 wholesalers*

PUBLISHER NAME INDEX

The Publisher Name Index is arranged alphabetically by the abbreviated publisher names used in the bibliographic entries of **Books In Print**. Other information in each entry includes ISBN prefix(es), business affiliation, if any; ordering and/or editorial address(es); SAN (Standard Address Number(s)); telephone number(s); fax number(s); toll-free telephone number(s); imprint(s) with their name abbreviation(s); and e-mail and Web site address(es). Addresses without a specific label are for editorial offices, other than ordering purposes. Associated distributor(s) are listed at the end of each entry. (For full information on distributors, including complete address information, see

the Wholesaler & Distributor Name Index.)

Foreign publishers' names are followed by the applicable three-character ISO (International Standards Organization) country code, the company's ISBN prefix (es), and a cross-reference to the U.S.-based distributor. For example:

Amsterdam U Pr. (NLD) (90-5356) Dist. by **U of Mich Pr.**

A dagger (†) preceding a publisher's name and the note "CIP" at the end of any entry both indicate that the publisher participates in the Cataloging in Publication Program of the Library of Congress. See sample entry on the following page.

Cross-reference lines marked with an asterisk (*) indicate company name changes that have occurred since the last edition of **Books In Print** and **Subject Guide to Book In Print**.

WHOLESALE & DISTRIBUTOR NAME INDEX

The Wholesaler & Distributor Name Index is arranged alphabetically by company abbreviated name and contains business affiliation as well as ISBN prefix(es), when available; full address and ordering information; SAN(s); and telephone, fax and toll-free numbers, e-mail and Web site addresses. See sample entry on the following page.
