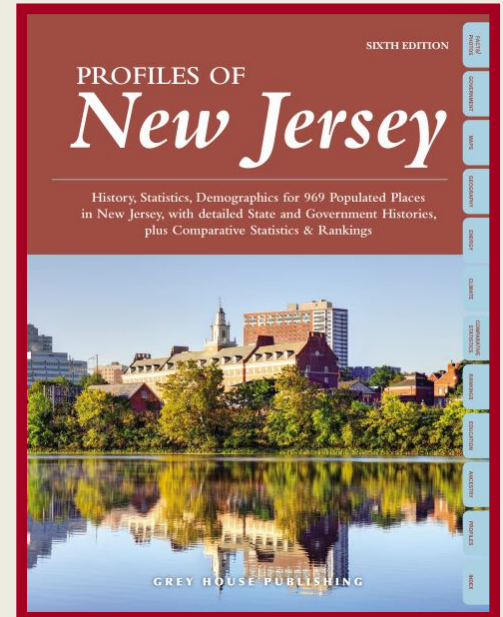

## *Profiles of New Jersey*

“This is the 5th edition of *Profiles of New Jersey*, based in part on content from the 4-volume *Profiles of America* and including an updated New Jersey chapter and **new information on number of dentists per capita, air quality index values, and selected monthly owner costs with and without a mortgage**. The front matter includes an introduction and extensive user guide followed by section 1, About New Jersey, which includes information on such things as state flower, state bug, state governor, and state time zone. Color maps, color photographs, a brief state history, a New Jersey state timeline, basic government information, facts on the state’s land and natural resources, a state energy profile, and a series of demographic maps (in color) are provided. The volume supplies profiles of 877 places based on 2010 US Census data and the most recent American Community Survey. The places are arranged alphabetically within counties. In the profiles, users will find information on the geography, population (including density, ethnicity, race, household size), employment, income, educational attainment, housing (rates of homeownership, median home value, median year structure was built, and more), health insurance, safety, transportation, and school districts (if applicable).

**A “Place Name Index” at the end of this section makes it easy for researchers to jump to a particular place.** The Comparative Statistics section allows users to find data about the 100 largest incorporated places, townships, and CDPs (Census Designated Places) using different data points (population, commute to work, marriage status, etc.). Community Rankings provides information on 150 places with populations over 2,500, ranking them in ascending and descending order based on employment, ancestry, marital status, crime, and more. The Education section offers an overall profile of New Jersey schools, New Jersey’s National Assessment of Education Progress, and school district rankings. The final sections provide profiles of ancestry, ethnicity, and climate. **This curated, reliable, easy-to-use reference is recommended.”**
